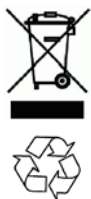
Installation instructions for **kit number 9010355**

SYNOPSIS:

This kit contains the parts needed to install a vacuum wand kit on T12 scrubbers.
Please follow step-by-step instructions.

SPECIAL TOOLS / CONSIDERATIONS: NONE

PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT

Please dispose of packaging materials, old machine components, and hazardous fluids in an environmentally safe manner according to local waste disposal regulations.

PREPARATION:

1. Empty the recovery tank. Refer to the Operator Manual for instructions how to empty the recovery tank.
2. Park the machine on a clean level surface, turn off the machine, and remove the key.

FOR SAFETY: Before leaving or servicing machine, stop on level surface, turn off machine, and remove key.

INSTALLATION:

1. Remove the existing recovery tank vacuum hose from the machine. Discard the vacuum hose. (Fig. 1)
2. Remove the vacuum fan cover from the machine. Set the mounting hardware aside. (Fig. 1)

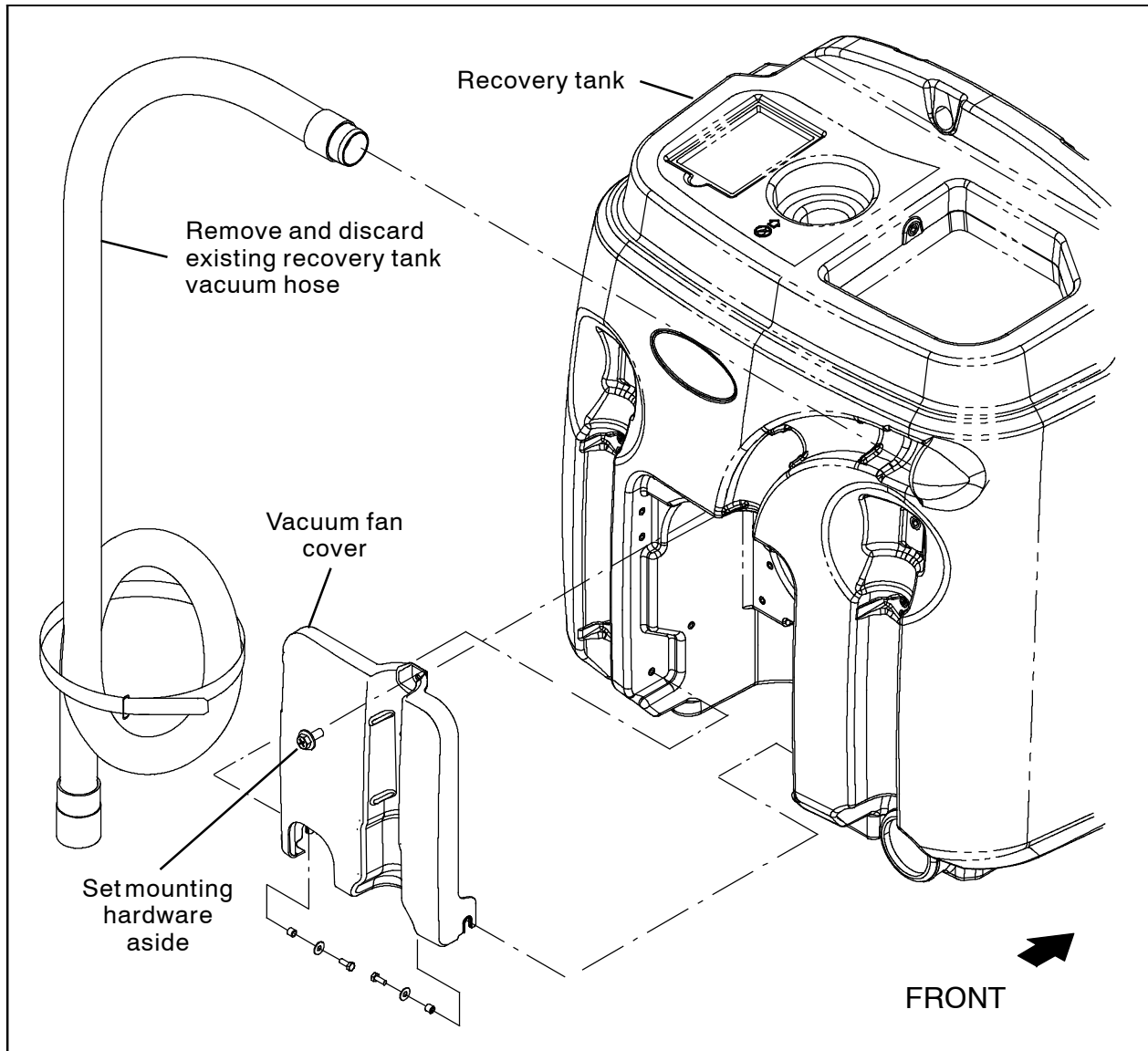

3. Drill two holes into the vacuum fan cover.
(Fig. 2)

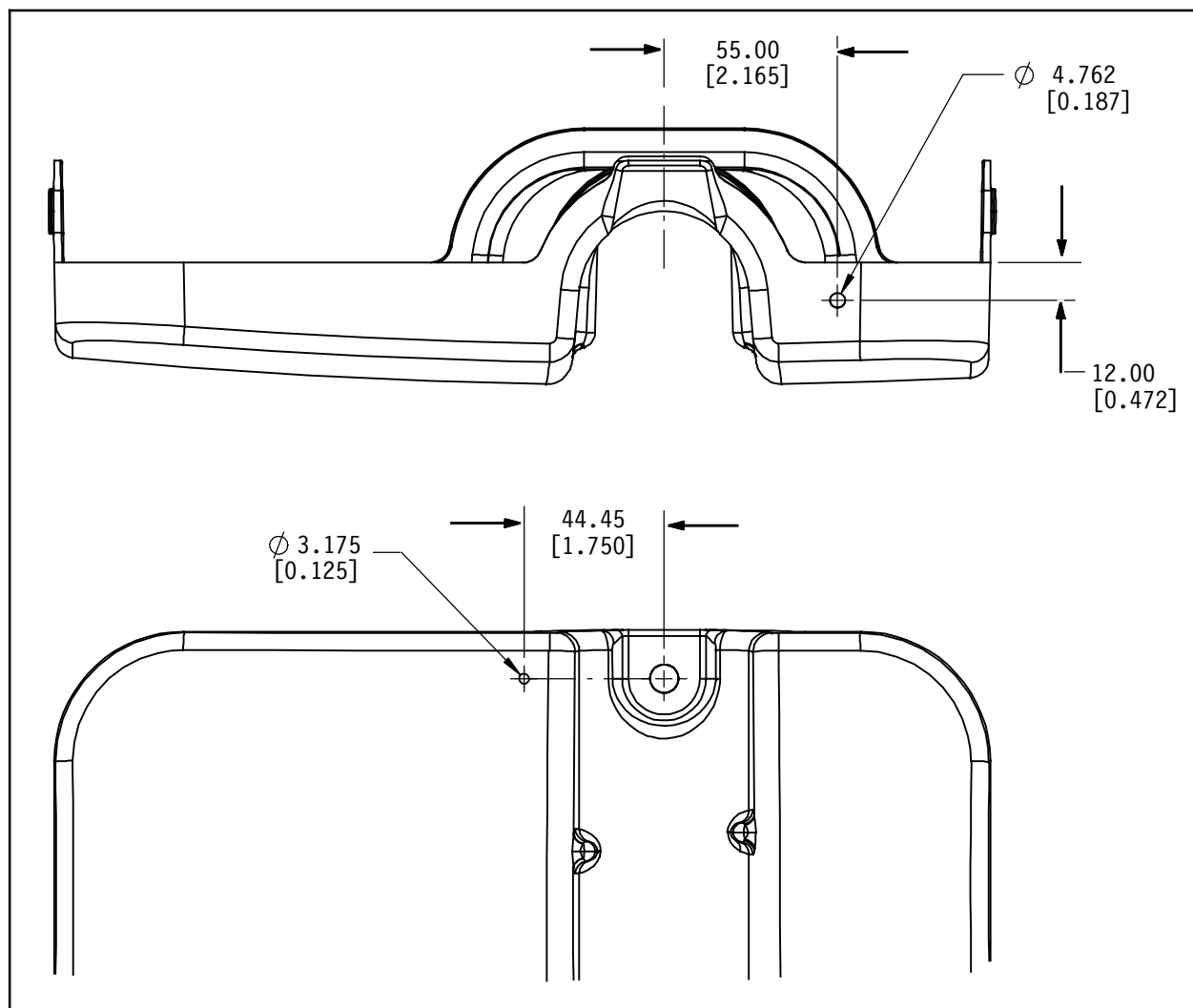

4. Use a rivet (16) and flat washer (17) to install the retainer strap (15) onto the vacuum fan cover. (Fig. 3)
5. Use a rivet (19) and a flat washer (20) to install the snap (18) onto the vacuum fan cover. (Fig. 3)
6. Reinstall the vacuum fan cover onto the recovery tank. (Fig. 3)
7. Install the adapter cuff (1) onto the rear squeegee assembly. (Fig. 3)
8. Install the vacuum wand handle (8) onto the swivel adapter (10). (Fig. 3)
9. Install the vacuum wand hose (13) onto the vacuum wand handle (8) and swivel adapter (10). (Fig. 3)
10. Insert the loose end of the vacuum wand hose (13) into the recovery tank. (Fig. 3)
11. If necessary, move the port cover (3) from over the hole in the wand (2). (Fig. 3)

Note: Most of vacuum wand assembly is pre-assembled. **Do Not** disassemble vacuum wand assembly

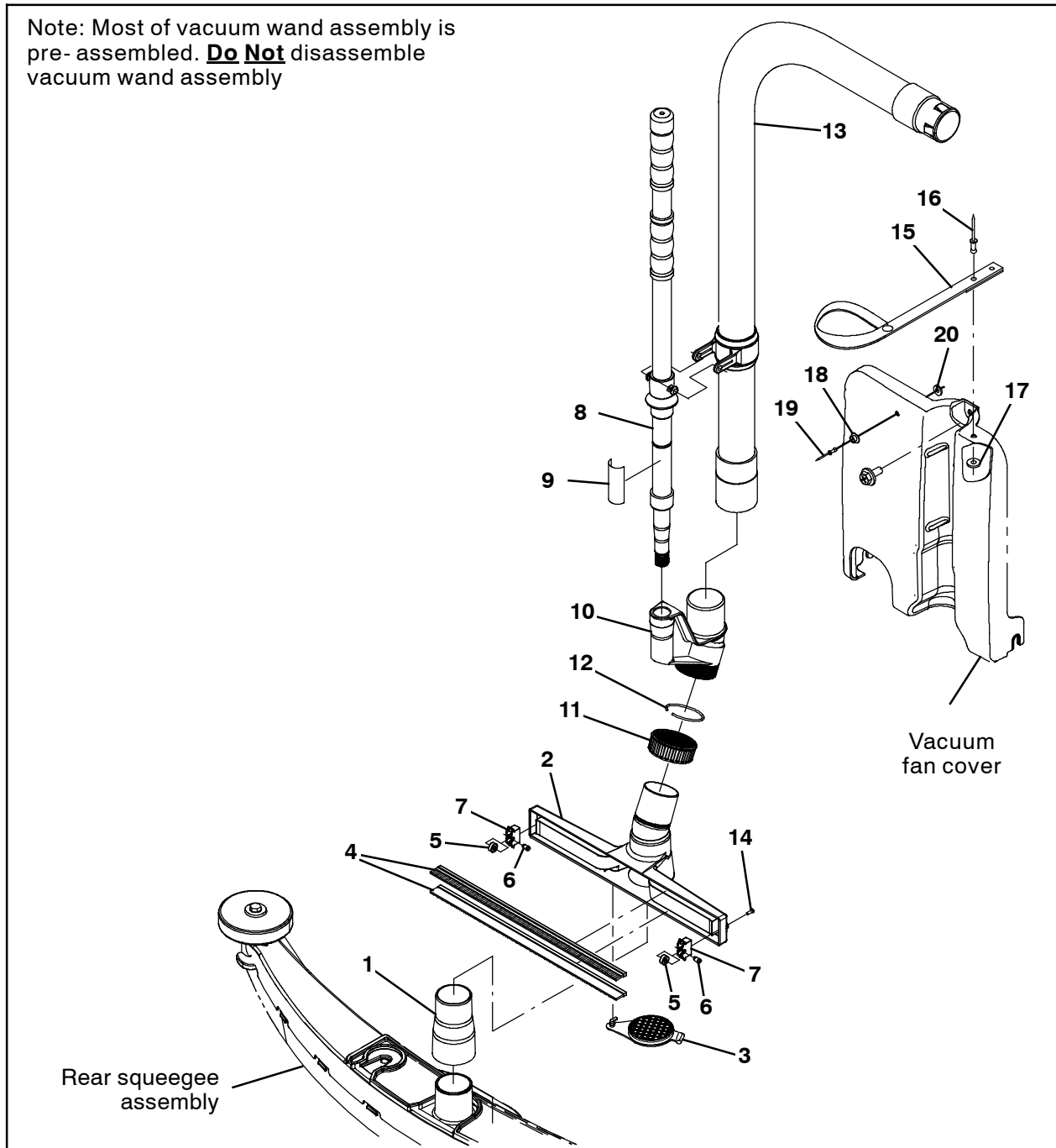

12. Install the vacuum wand assembly onto the adapter cuff (1) installed on the rear squeegee assembly and insert the vacuum hose into the vacuum hose recess in the recovery tank. (Fig. 3 / Fig. 4)
13. Snap the retainer strap (15) onto the vacuum fan cover (21) to secure the vacuum wand assembly to the machine. (Fig. 3 / Fig. 4)
14. Start and test the machine. Operate the vacuum wand to ensure it functions. Refer to Operator Manual for instructions how to operate the vacuum wand.
